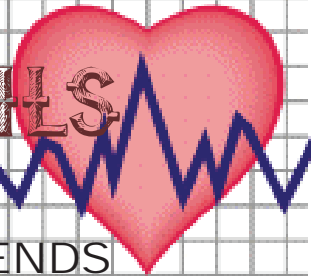

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From 1-4, exit onto CR 559 and head south. Turn right onto 559A then left onto Berkley Road. Follow Berkley Road to the intersection with Denton Avenue, take a right at the light. Trailhead is on right side of the road.



ATTRIBUTES



Auburndale TECO Trail is a 5.5 mile, non-motorized, multi-use trail extending from the trailhead located on Denton Avenue to Daniels Road. The 12-foot wide paved trail which bypasses Lake Myrtle Park, was constructed along an abandoned railroad right-of-way. The easy grade makes the trail accessible to all ability levels.

Things to See

Where eagles soar! About .3 miles from the beginning of the trail, you will see an eagle's nest to the slight south west. The nest can be seen from an observation area located on the west side of the trail. Trekking with Rover? Visit the new two-acre Auburndale Dog Park just .25 miles from the trailhead.

**BEST TO ACCESS GEOCACHE FROM BRADDOCK ROAD CROSSING!
TREK TEN CACHE COORDINATES: N 28° 06.125 W 081° 49.358**



FIND THE CACHE WITHOUT GPS: Begin at the trailhead parking lot, continue past the soccer fields a short distance beyond the one-mile marker on the bike path where you will see some exercise equipment. When you reach the exercise equipment, look to the east for a large oak tree. The cache is at the base of the tree.
